GDPR PRIVACY EXHIBIT

If you are in the European Union, please note that this section may apply to our processing of your Personal Data in addition to the other terms of this Privacy Policy, in accordance with the *General Data Protection Regulation* (EU) 2016/679 (“**GDPR**”).

When we act as Data Processor

For activities where we provide Services to our corporate customers, we act only on the instruction of those corporate customers. In those situations, the corporate customer is the Data Controller and we process your data in our capacity as a Data Processor on behalf of the Data Controller. In those circumstances, you should exercise your data subject rights by contacting the Data Controller directly.

When we act as Data Controller

If we process your personal information in our capacity as a Data Controller, the following applies:

We collect, use, and share your personal information where we are satisfied that we have an appropriate legal basis to do this. This may be because:

- Our use of your personal information is in our legitimate interest as a commercial organization. In such a case, you have a right to object to the processing as explained in the section below titled *Your Rights under the GDPR*.
- Our use of your personal information is necessary to comply with a relevant legal or regulatory obligation that we have; or
- Our use of your personal information is in accordance with your consent.

Your rights under the GDPR

With respect to the *User Rights* section, you have the following rights:

- Erase your personal information: You can ask us to erase or delete all or some of your personal information (for instance, if it is no longer necessary to provide our services to you).
- Object to or restrict our processing of your personal information: You can ask us to stop using all or some of your personal information (for instance, if we have no legal right to keep using it) or to restrict our use of it (for instance, if your personal information is inaccurate).

- Right to portability: You can ask us to provide a copy in machine-readable form of the personal information that you have provided us.

How to exercise your Rights

In situations where we are a Data Controller, if you would like to exercise any of the rights described above, please send us an email at privacy@ship4wd.com. In your message, please indicate the right you would like to exercise and the information that you would like to access, correct, delete or export.

We may ask you for additional information to confirm your identity and for security purposes, before disclosing personal information requested to you. We reserve the right to charge a fee where permitted by law, for instance, if your request is manifestly unfounded or excessive.

We may not always be able to fully address your request, for example, if it would impact the duty of confidentiality we owe to others, or if we are legally entitled to deal with the request in a different way.

Cross-border Transfer of Information

We generally maintain servers and systems in the United States hosted by service providers. We also may subcontract the processing of your data to, or otherwise share your data with, other third parties in the United States or countries other than your country of residence. As a result, if your personal information is sent outside the European Economic Area for the purposes described above, we will take steps to ensure that the information receives an adequate level of protection, including by entering into data protection agreements using Standard Contractual Clauses or using other lawful transfer mechanisms.
